Creating a PDF Space

1. Open Acrobat Studio and navigate to the Acrobat home page.
2. Select PDF Spaces to begin creating a new space.
3. Drag and drop files into the PDF Space. Files can be Word, PDF, PowerPoint, or other formats, with a limit of 100 sources, each up to 100 MB and 600 pages.
4. Copy a URL, click Add Link, paste the URL, and confirm to include a hyperlink.
5. Click Create PDF Space to build the space.
6. Wait for Acrobat Studio to process the files and generate insights.

Adding Files to an Existing PDF Space

1. Open the existing PDF Space in Acrobat Studio.
2. Drag and drop additional files into the space.
3. Click Add to PDF Space from the file browser if you prefer.
4. Select the PDF Space you want to add the file to from the list of available spaces.
5. Confirm the addition, and the file will be integrated into the PDF Space.

Reviewing Insights and Notes

1. Review the insights displayed as cards once the PDF Space is built.
2. Click a card to view annotations and citations, which show the source document and the exact location of the information.
3. Save insights to the Notes panel by clicking Save to Note.
4. Open the Notes panel to edit the saved notes, rename them, or organize them as needed.

Selecting a Pre-Built AI Assistant

1. Open your PDF Space and click Choose an Assistant.
2. Select one of the pre-built assistants: Analyst, Entertainer, or Instructor.
3. Review the description of the assistant's functionality.

Creating a Customized AI Assistant

1. Click Choose an Assistant and select Create New Assistant.

Using Voice Chat on Mobile

1. Open the Chat tab in your PDF Space.
2. Use the voice chat feature to ask questions.
3. Listen to the AI-generated response or read the text response.
