Legal teams are responsible for some of the most document-heavy and risk-sensitive work in any organization.

In particular, three challenges contribute to the pressure of this work. For one, legal professionals are responsible for thoroughly reading and digesting dense and complex files that can run into the hundreds of pages. They also face fragmented collaboration tools and processes within their own departments and across their organizations. Finally, legal work comes with a high standard for accuracy and security; even small mistakes can lead to regulatory penalties or reputational damage.

Acrobat Studio, Adobe's integrated suite of tools for today's knowledge workers, combines PDF tools, AI-powered data extraction and analysis features, and content creation capabilities that help legal professionals solve some of their most pressing problems.

Summarize dense documents.

Nearly all legal professionals have a heavy reading load. It's simply part of the job, and most legal teams would never outsource their reading to AI tools, no matter how reliable those tools may be. Still, the Acrobat Studio AI Assistant tool provides powerful summary capabilities that can help legal professionals identify key insights from documents before they even begin reading.

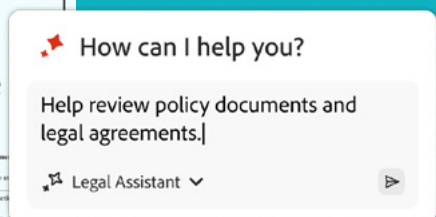
In a January 2025 analysis, Forrester found that AI Assistant improved the efficiency of document summarization and analysis by 45%. And in an interview for the analysis, one business manager at a legal organization told Forrester that the tool reduced the time required to review and summarize documents like legal briefs from 30 to 45 minutes down to just 5 minutes.

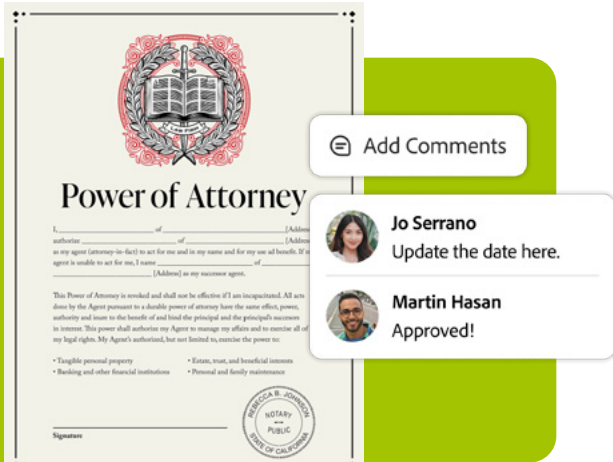
Unlike some large language models (LLMs), Acrobat Studio focuses its answers and insights on the documents provided by users. This helps alleviate concerns about AI "hallucinating" incorrect information. Acrobat Studio helps legal professionals review documents more efficiently, without having to worry that the platform is making things up. In fact, Acrobat Studio even includes clickable citations, allowing users to trace information back to its original source.

Keep sensitive information secure.

Acrobat Studio does not train AI models with customer data; it uses the security infrastructure of Adobe Acrobat to help keep data secure. This is especially important for legal professionals that handle private and sensitive information.

Acrobat Studio allows teams to embed passwords and permissions in documents, ensuring that only the intended recipients can read, copy, or edit their contents. Acrobat Studio also lets users scan paper documents and turn them into fully searchable and editable PDFs with permanent redaction capabilities.

Acrobat Studio features enterprise-grade security and administrative controls, including encryption, watermarking, sandboxed environments, and centralized oversight. Together, these features help legal teams ensure data protection, regulatory compliance, and governance at scale.

Improve team collaboration.

Acrobat Studio features PDF Spaces, a knowledge hub where users can upload up to 100 documents (of up to 600 pages each) in a single workspace. This is helpful for legal professionals who need to centralize drafts, memos, and policy updates in one place, with trackable annotations and comments. In addition to PDFs, PDF Spaces allows users to upload Word documents, slides, spreadsheets, transcripts, and web content, helping legal professionals find and share connections between resources.

Acrobat Studio also includes Adobe Express Premium. Teams can add branding and visual elements to documents using Express brand kits, stock assets, or custom AI-generated assets, and then deliver those documents securely as PDFs to relevant departments.

In its analysis, Forrester noted that Adobe's tools improve productivity across teams — not just within them. “The chief digital officer at a legal organization noted that AI Assistant enhanced productivity across various teams, including legal, IT, and executive leadership,” the Forrester report says.
